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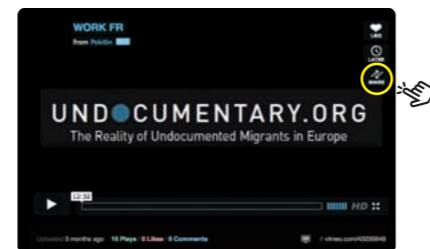
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## HOW TO USE SINGLE VIDEOS

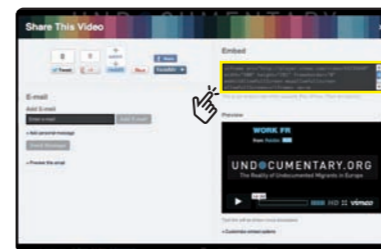
Irregular migration is a complex phenomenon, often misinterpreted and misunderstood. Written texts and oral presentations can sometimes fail to grab people's attention and to generate empathy when describing personal stories. Videos take more time and resources to be made, but are often more effective in "humanizing" the debate by sensitizing public awareness of an issue.

For this reason, "Undocumentary" videos can be used as a complement or support to any kind of awareness raising and advocacy activity. For example, videos can be integrated in any kind of digital written document. To embed a video in your page, **follow these steps:**

1. Select a video and click on the little icon "share".



2. A dialog box appears with the sharing options. At the top right corner, you can select the code and press CTRL + C to copy it.



Now go to your site:

3. Select the page where you want to embed the video;
4. In the html mode of the page, place the cursor at the spot where you want to show the video;
5. Press CTRL+V (paste for Windows) or Command+C (paste for MacOs) to paste the code into the page;
6. If you are posting on a blog, you may need to wrap the embedding code between <code></code> tags.

**Videos can also support oral presentations,** and be integrated in Power Point or other slide presentation programs (easy and short tutorials on how to do this are available on-line);

**Videos can be shared** on social media for advocacy, campaigning or simply to provide examples in support of an argument.

## WHAT IS “UNDOCUMENTARY”?

“Undocumentary” is a web-documentary on the situation of undocumented migrants living in Europe. With this project, PICUM aims to give a voice to undocumented migrants who let us into their everyday lives and share their experiences of living and working in the shadows. The aim is to debunk myths and stereotypes around irregular migration, raise awareness on the situation of undocumented migrants living in Europe and reach out to new audiences through the use of new multimedia tools.

“Undocumentary” is an interactive website with predominantly video content. Text and pictures support the videos that are intended to be shared through different social media platforms, such as Facebook and Twitter.

The website is designed to facilitate users’ access and exchange of information through an appealing web design, a user-oriented organization of the content and an intensive use of videos. An interactive map shows how to find PICUM’s member organisations in Europe and beyond. A “take action” section explains to the viewer the different ways to get involved.

Thanks to the three language versions (EN, FR, and ES), organisations will be able to organise **screening events** or use the videos as an **advocacy tool** to illustrate the subject of their work for presentations and workshops. Teachers will have the possibility to download an **educational dossier** to support their lessons on the subject. Thanks to its different layers of information, **undocumentary.org** is an opportunity for people with different personal and professional backgrounds to improve their knowledge about a key global issue.

## HOW TO USE THE “UNDOCUMENTARY” WEBSITE

“Undocumentary” is not only videos, but also photos, text, design and web features aimed at making the content of the website more accessible and shareable. “Undocumentary” can be used in the following ways:

### Advocacy

By sharing videos and content on the internet, users play a part in advocating for respect of undocumented migrants’ rights. Sharing is only one way of taking action. Other actions implying different levels of engagement are outlined in the “Take Action” page of each section.

### Awareness raising and learning

“Undocumentary” can be used to offer varied kind of information to meet the needs of different users. For example, thematic videos and Q&A represent a first layer of information. Full-interviews provide a second layer concerning thematic videos. PICUM publications offer more in-depth and policy oriented information, not only related to the specific videos, but also to the broader issue of irregular migration.

### Teaching

### Networking

“Undocumentary” presents and compares the work of various PICUM member and partner organisations and provides the user with an interactive map that pinpoints PICUM members in different countries including basic information on how to get in contact.

To summarize, “Undocumentary” can be used for different purposes and in different situations, such as public presentations at workshops and conferences, teaching classes at schools and universities, ad hoc screenings, social media activities, personal interest etc.
